MATHS

In Maths with Miss Evans year 2 will be focusing on multiplication and division. We will then move our learning on to word problems.

Year 2 will still have a weekly test on a Friday which will cover their quick mental maths knowledge. These tests cover doubles, halving, number bonds and times tables! When the children have mastered a concept they will move on.

Please can you ensure you are accessing numbots and times table rockstars regularly with your child! When your child has left year 2, they are expected to know their 2, 5 and 10 times table. **Please revisit topics regularly.**

In the front of their yellow quick mental maths books Miss Evans has placed a checklist with the topics they are secure on, the aim is to master these basic skills. Some children have now moved onto further timetables, this is not included on the checklist.
